MFSS strives to achieve the best outcomes possible for children, families and the community, by promoting and supporting safe children, strong families and supportive communities.

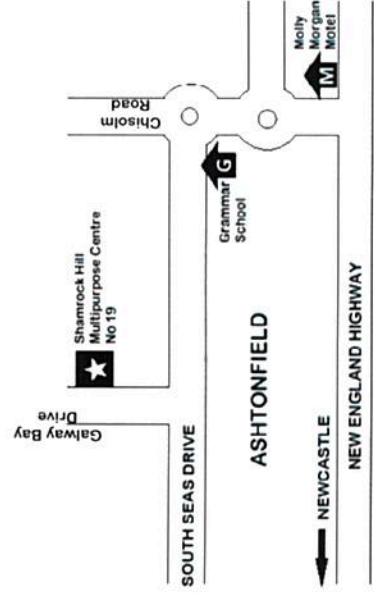
OUR BELIEFS:
